Maastricht.

Height 25.8 cm

Marked with the town mark of Valenciennes and maker's n

J.B. Dannezan (active 1682-1741)

France, first half 18th century

A pair of plates

Diameter 37.2 cm

Marked with a crowned rose with maker's initials 'IVA' and
mark with name Ian

Probably Leiden, first quarter 18th century



Two flagons of the Carpenter's Guild, on the body engraved garland of flowers with various carpenter's utensils. In the double base with holes were originally dice

Height 22.5 cm

Maker's mark of Johann Jacob Jürgen Witter, Wismar (active 1745- circa 1753)

On each of the lids engraved text 'Jochim Jacob Lühnborg 1746 and Johan Urtman 1746'

Mid 18th century
