

Drinking vessel, so-called Sugerli Height 19cm Marked on inside with a medaillon with a bear and the initials 'sG' possibly Steckhorn, Andrea Würger Switzerland, 1750-1825 Flagon with spout, so-called Stegkan Height 31.7cm Marked on the lid with the town mark of Bern and initials 'HP' Johannes Heinrich Petersohn, active 1770-1786 Switzerland Flagon with spout, so-called Stegkan Height 26.6cm
Marked on the lid twice crowned 'E' and makersmark with initials 'AG' Abraham Ganting, Bern, 1729-1756 or 1743-1770
The body is engraved with the initials 'PB' and 'EBED' and dated '1748'
