1 A pair of French deep plates, the border with fleur-de-lys mark, 17th Century, 25 cm diam. (2)

2 A pair of German church pricket candlesticks with broad circular drippan, multibaluster stem, the triangular base with feathers and flowerheads, on curved legs, 18th Century, 74 cm high (2)

3 A Scottish baluster-shaped measure of gill capacity, scroll handle with shell-shaped thumbpiece to the domed cover, on spreading circular base, 19th Century, 9 cm high

4 A rare benitier, the shaped handle hanging in hearts, on raised circular base, 17th/18th Century, 9 cm high

5 A Dutch pear-shaped feeding-bottle with screw top with scroll spout, 18th/19th Century, 21.5 cm high

10 A Dutch Louis XV cabaret, the accolade border with shell motifs, on bracket feet, 18th/19th Century, 30 cm diam.



25 Three various Dutch vase-shaped pepper-pots, 19th Century; and a German plate, the moulded border with initials H.P., 19th Century, 28 cm diam. (4)

26 A pair of Dutch black lacquered gold decorated candlesticks on square bases, 19th Century, 18 cm high; a tin black lacquered gold decorated biscuit-box, on tray, with accolade border, 19th Century (3)

27 A pair of candlesticks, tapering stem, on square base, 19th Century, 23.5 cm high (2)

f 150-250

28 A German charger with moulded rim, 19th Century, 30.5 cm diam.; two plates with moulded rims, 19th Century, 24 cm diam.; a Dutch cylindrical measure of deciliter capacity, 10 cm high; and three other various pewter objects (7)

29 A Dutch pear-shaped coffee-urn with scroll wood handle, on three scroll feet, 19th Century, 35 cm high

f 600-800

30 A vase-shaped pepper-pot, 19th Century; a cylindrical measure of half liter capacity, 19th Century; a small bowl and cover; and a charger, the moulded rim with initials, 18th/19th Century, 36 cm diam. (4)

f 300-400

31 A German brandy-bowl with griffinshaped handles, the body engraved with stylised flowers, on raised circular base, 18th Century, 13.5 cm wide; and a German deep bowl with two handles, 19th Century, 18 cm diam. (2)

f 400-600

32 A baluster-shaped flagon with spout, plain handle and plain thumbpiece to the domed cover, engraved with number XXIII, on raised circular base, 19th Century, 20 cm high

f 600-800

33 A Dutch baluster-shaped flagon with spout, scroll handle and shell-shaped thumbpiece to the domed cover, on raised circular base, 19th Century, 26 cm high *f* 600-800

34 A Dutch or Flemish baluster-shaped flagon with spout, scroll handle, shell-shaped thumbpiece to the domed cover, on raised circular base, 19th Century, 24 cm high

f 700-1.000

35 Two German cylindrical tankards, scroll handle, ball thumbpiece to the domed cover, 19th Century, 17.5 cm high (2)

f 400-600

36 A pair of French commemorative chargers, the moulded borders engraved with name and date Anne Catherine Balaine 1799, the platter with two birds above a heart and flanked by flowers, 40.5 cm diam. (2)

f 600-800

37 A German charger with moulded border, the platter engraved with a basket of flowers, the reverse with touchmarks of IB Finck, Mainz, 18th Century, 34 cm diam.; and a French charger, the double moulded rim with text Roy and flanked by two crowns, 18th Century, 35 cm diam. (2)

f 450-650

38 A German or Austrian cylindrical tankard, scroll handle, plain thumbpiece to the cover with knob finial, on spreading circular base, 19th Century, 17.5 cm high

f 300-500

39 Two cylindrical measures of litre and decilitre capacity, 19th Century, 20.5 cm and 10 cm high (2)

f 300-400

40 A fine Swiss baluster-shaped flagon, scroll handle, double ram's mask thumbpiece and a ram's mask finial to the heart-shaped cover with touchmark and initials and date LB 1768 and LXXVIII, the rim with Wallis touchmark, on spreading circular base, 18th Century, 32 cm high

46 A fine French baluster-shaped flagon, plain handle, double acorn thumbpiece to the raised cover with initials AL, on circular base, the bottom marked Toulouse, late 17th Century, 17 cm high
