- 148 A large bulbous bronze cooking pot with iron handle, on three tapering legs, 17th Century, 37 cm diam.; another, smaller, lacking the swing handle, 17th Century, 24 cm diam. (2)

- 149 A German pewter plate, the rim with text and date 1834, the platter engraved with a basket of flowers, 31 cm diam.
f 100-200
- 150 A Dutch pewter pear-shaped coffee-urn with tap, loose cover, wood handle, cabriole legs, on triangular burner, 19th Century, 38 cm high
f 400-600
- 151 A Dutch pewter inkstand with inkwell, caster and box, 19th Century
f 300-400
- 152 A Dutch pear-shaped black lacquered pewter coffee-urn with gold floral decoration, tap, scroll legs, on triangular brass burner, 19th Century, 42 cm high
f 600-800
- 153 A German waved oval pewter dish with decorated border, 44 cm wide; and a circular plate en suite, 25 cm diam., both 19th Century (2)
f 200-300
- 154 A pewter chamber-pot made into a cachepot with waved rim; a Britannia metal teapot; and a Britannia metal coffee-pot, all 19th Century (3)
f 150-200
- 155 A Dutch pewter charger with moulded rim, 19th Century, 35 cm diam.; and a Kaiserzinn Art Nouveau saucer (2)
f 300-400
- 156 A pair of pewter chestnut vases with loose covers, the body with lion's masks with ring handles, on raised oval base, 19th Century (2)
f 400-600
- 157 Two various Dutch baluster-shaped pewter flagons with spouts, shell-shaped thumb-pieces and domed covers, 19th Century (2)
f 500-800
- 158 A Dutch pewter vase-shaped coffee-urn, the body with lion's masks and ring handles, brass tap, on three scroll legs, 19th Century
f 300-400
- 159 A Dutch cylindrical pewter butter-pot with screw top; a Dutch cylindrical sand-caster; and a cylindrical hanging soap-bucket, all 19th Century (3)
f 200-300
- 160 A Dutch pear-shaped pewter coffee-urn, scroll handle, tap, on three scroll feet, triangular brass burner, 19th Century (2)
f 700-1.000
- 161 Four pewter tankards of pint capacity, the body engraved with names, 19th Century (4)
f 300-500
- 162 Four cylindrical Dutch pewter measures, three 19th Century (4)
f 200-300
- 163 A small baluster-shaped pewter flagon, heart-shaped cover, double-acorn thumb-piece and scroll handle; and a brass hanging oil lamp (2)
