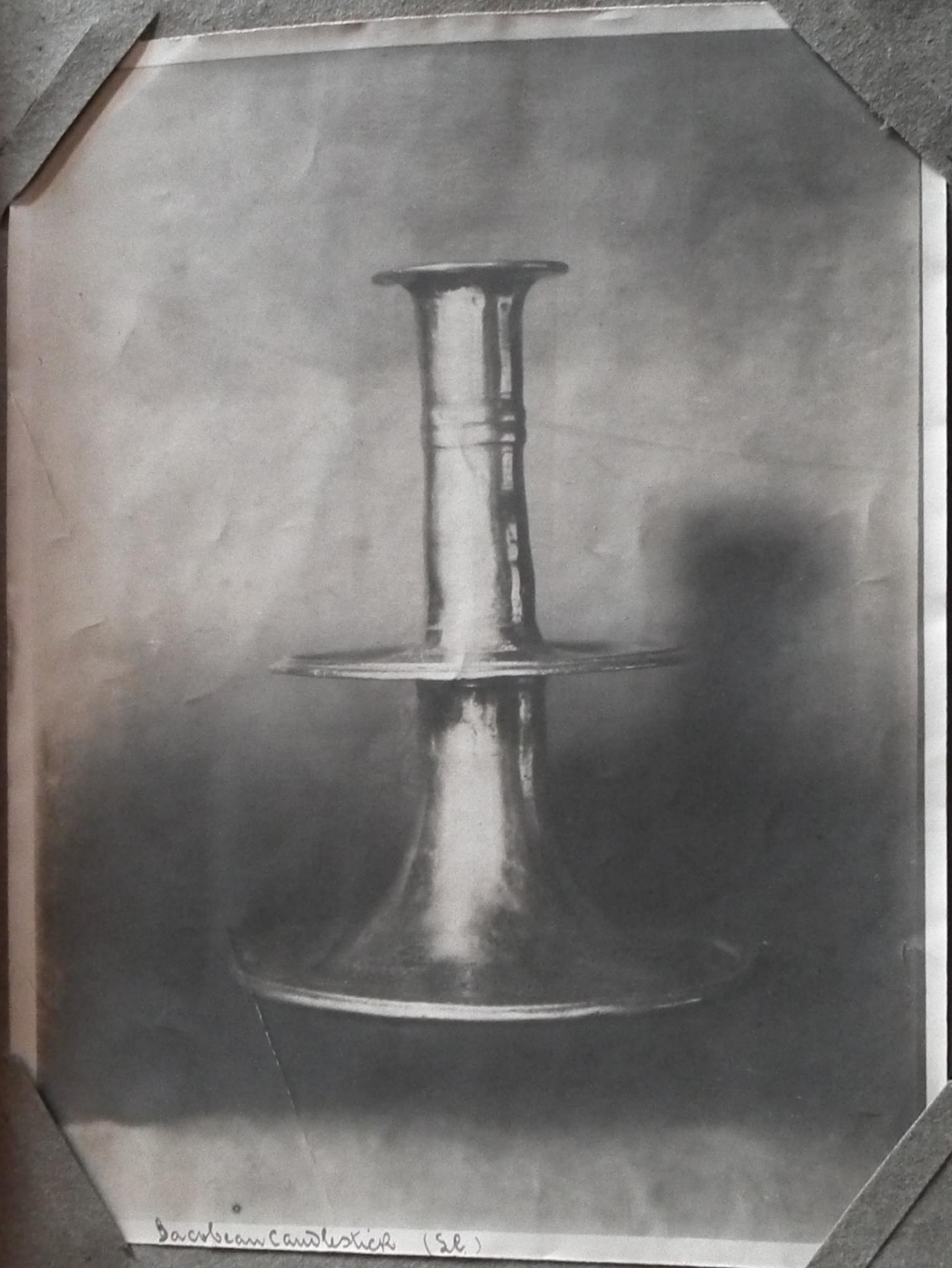

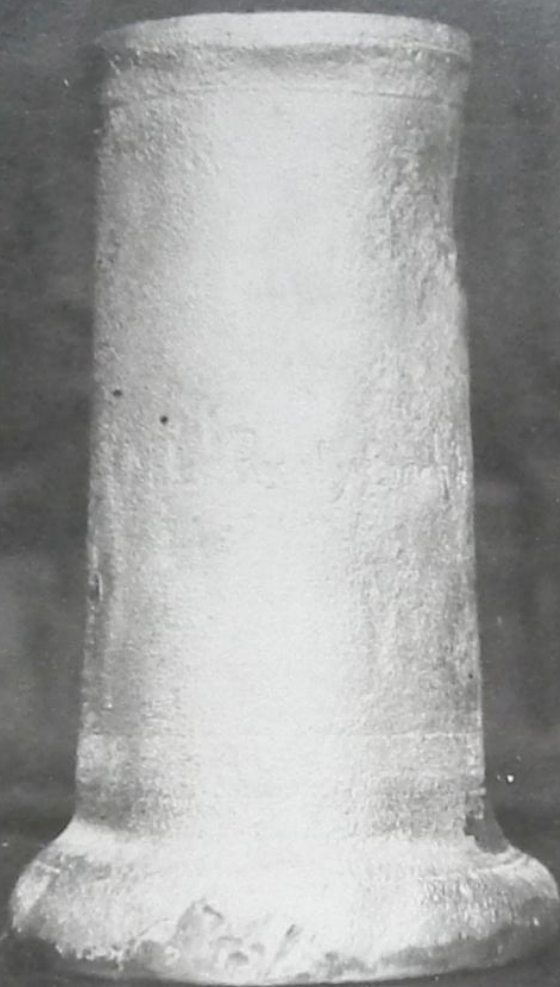
Jacobean Candlestick (SL)

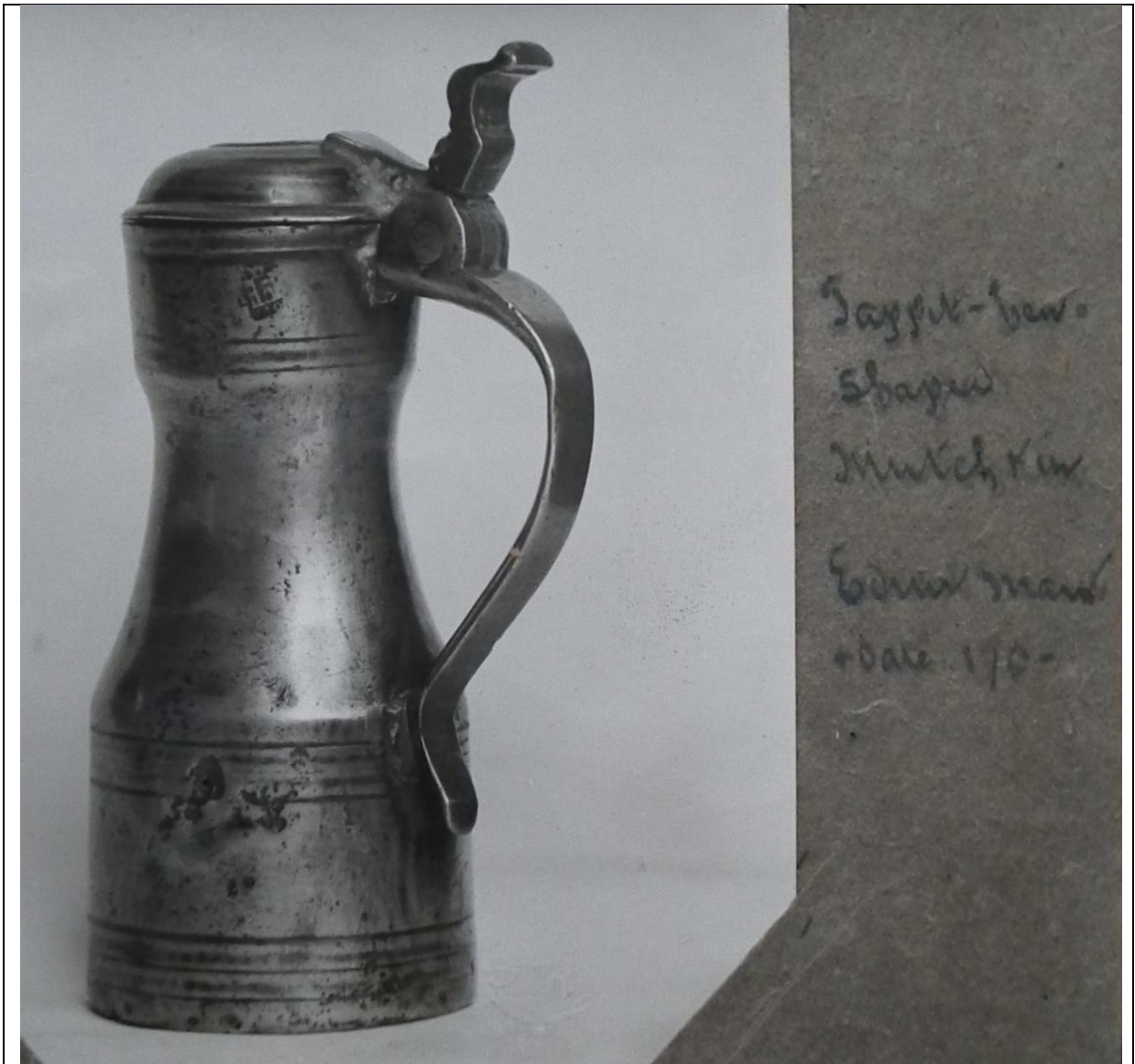

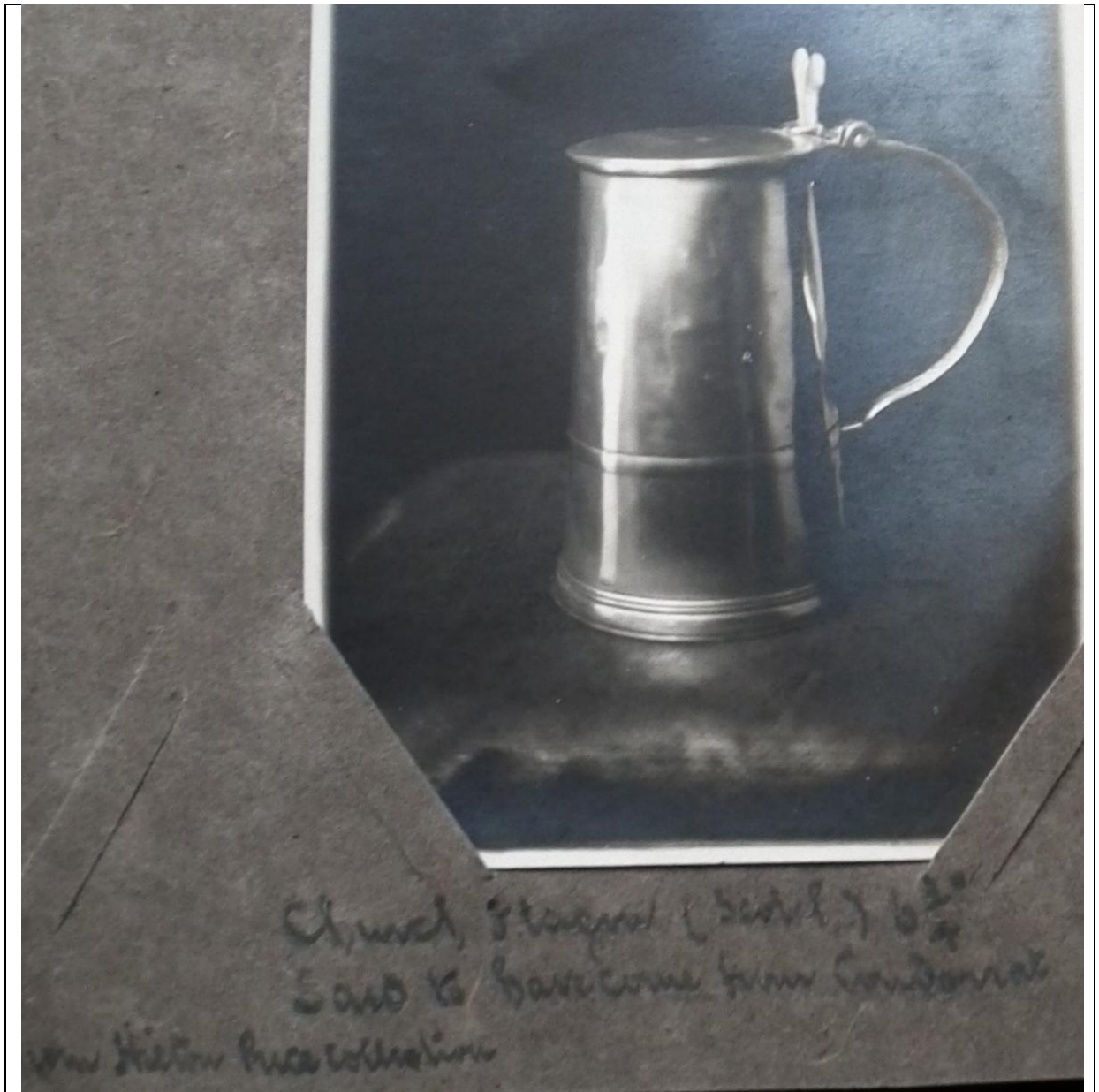


Silver 8 1/2" dia. wide, simple with ornamentation

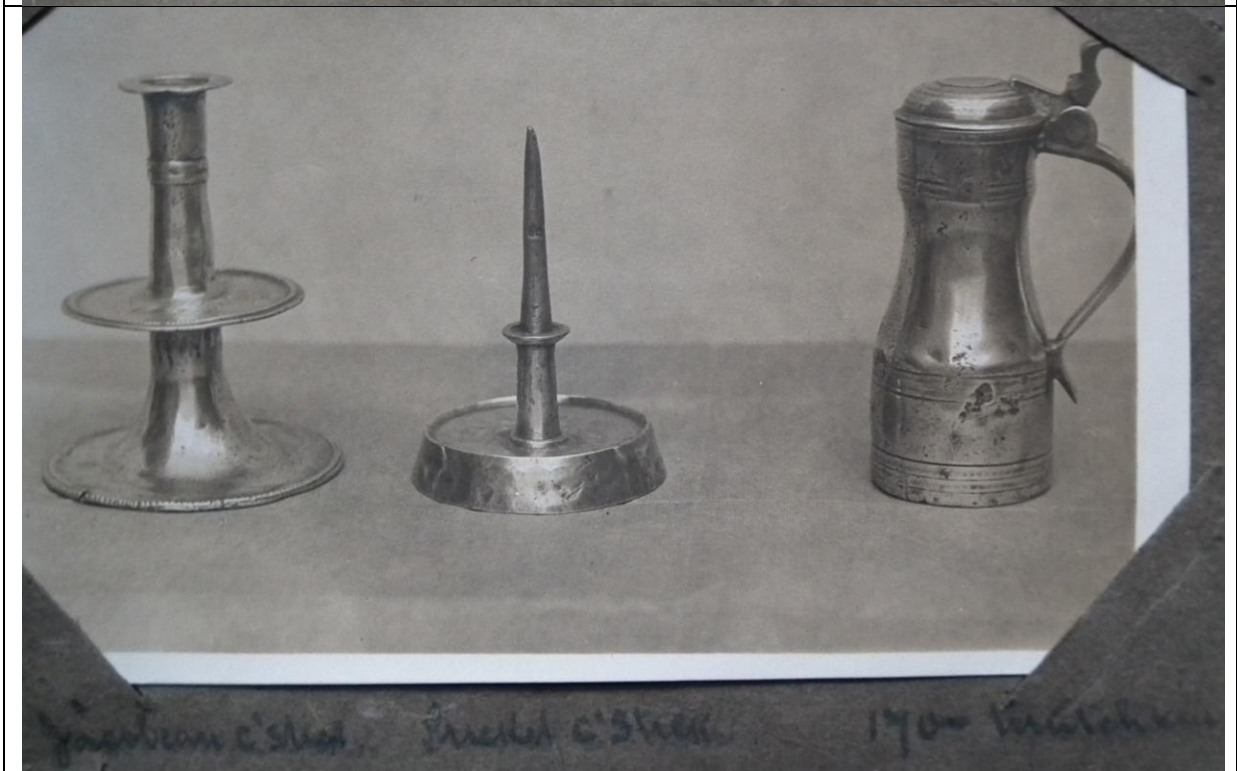

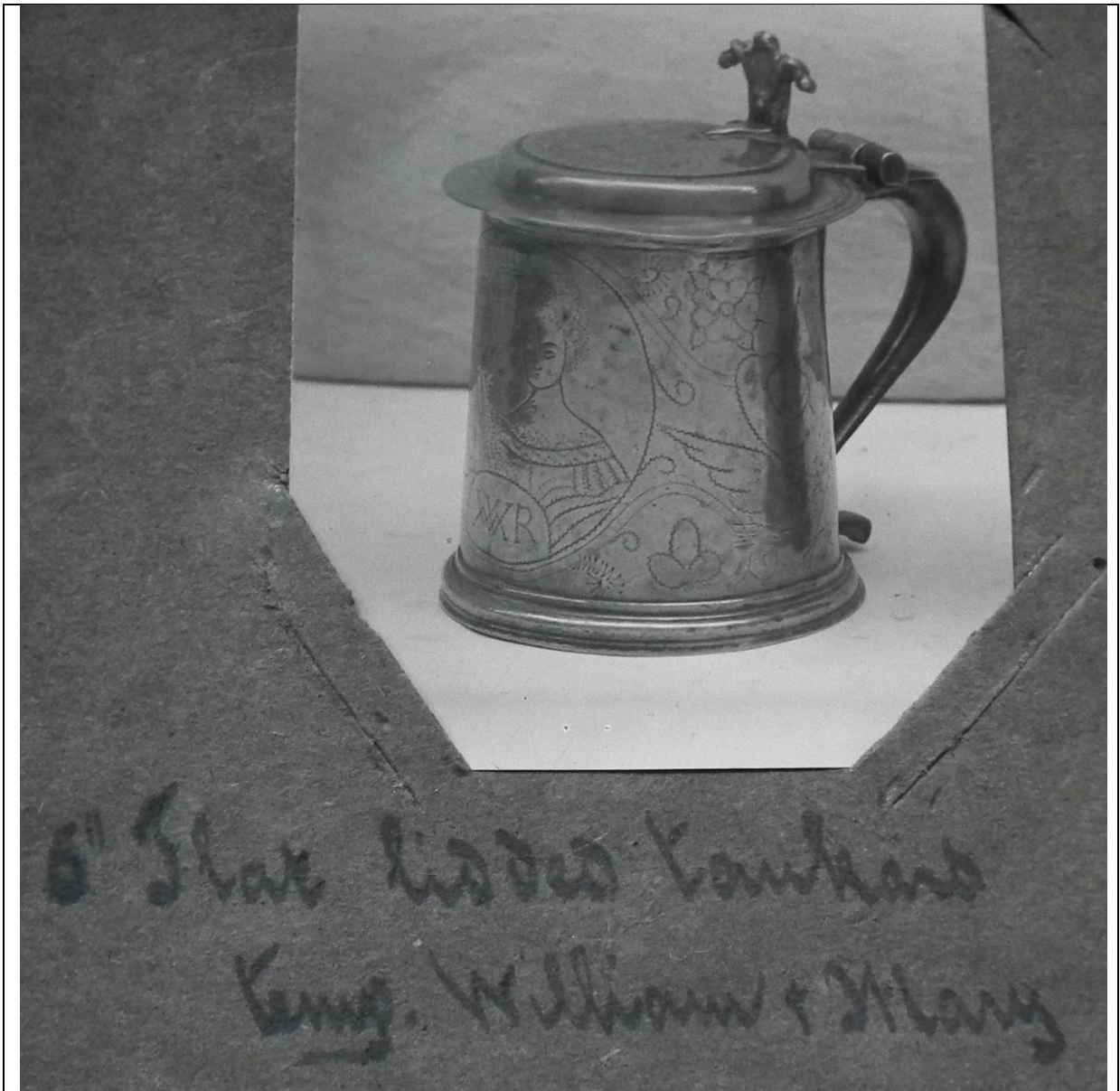

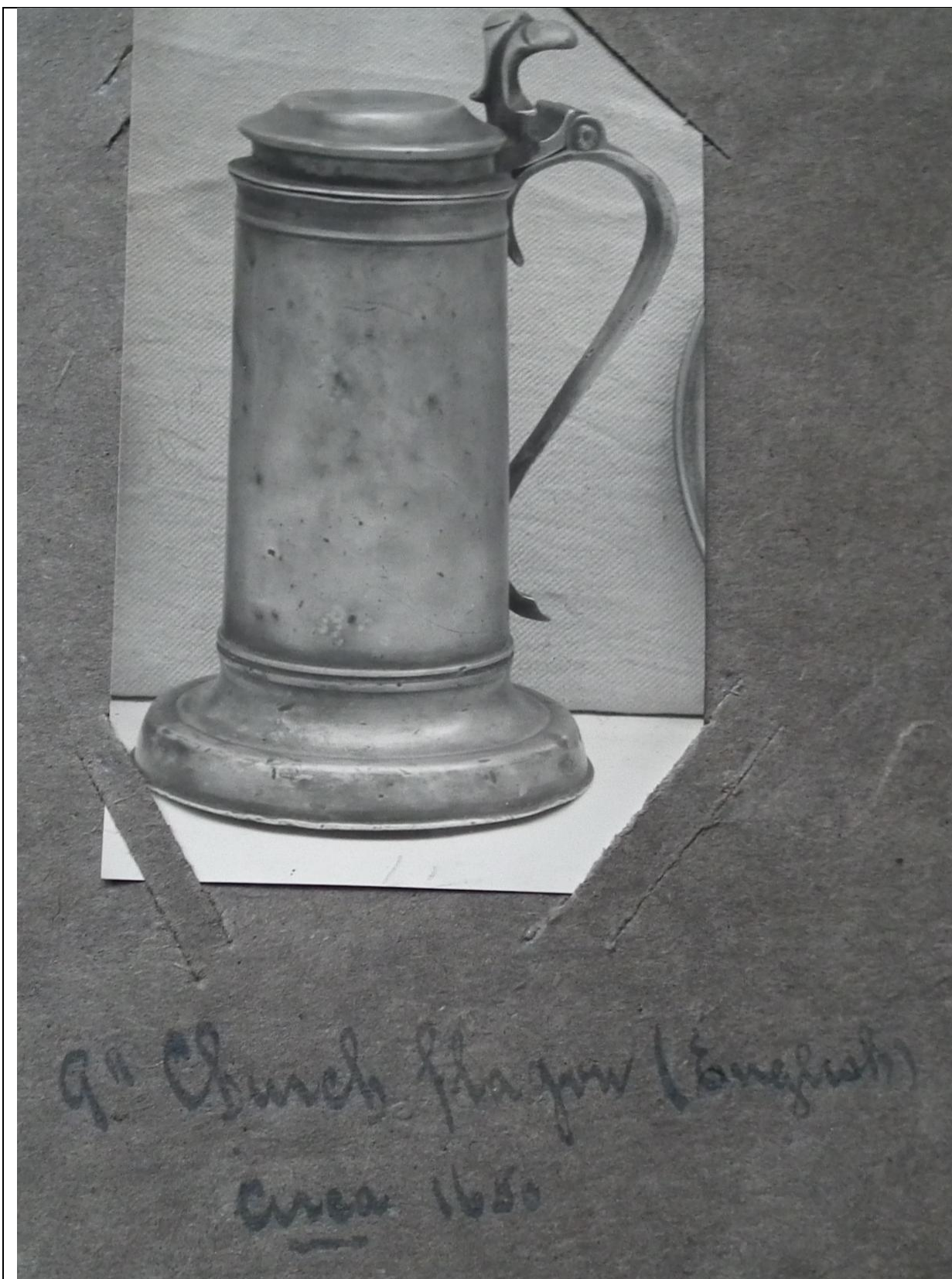

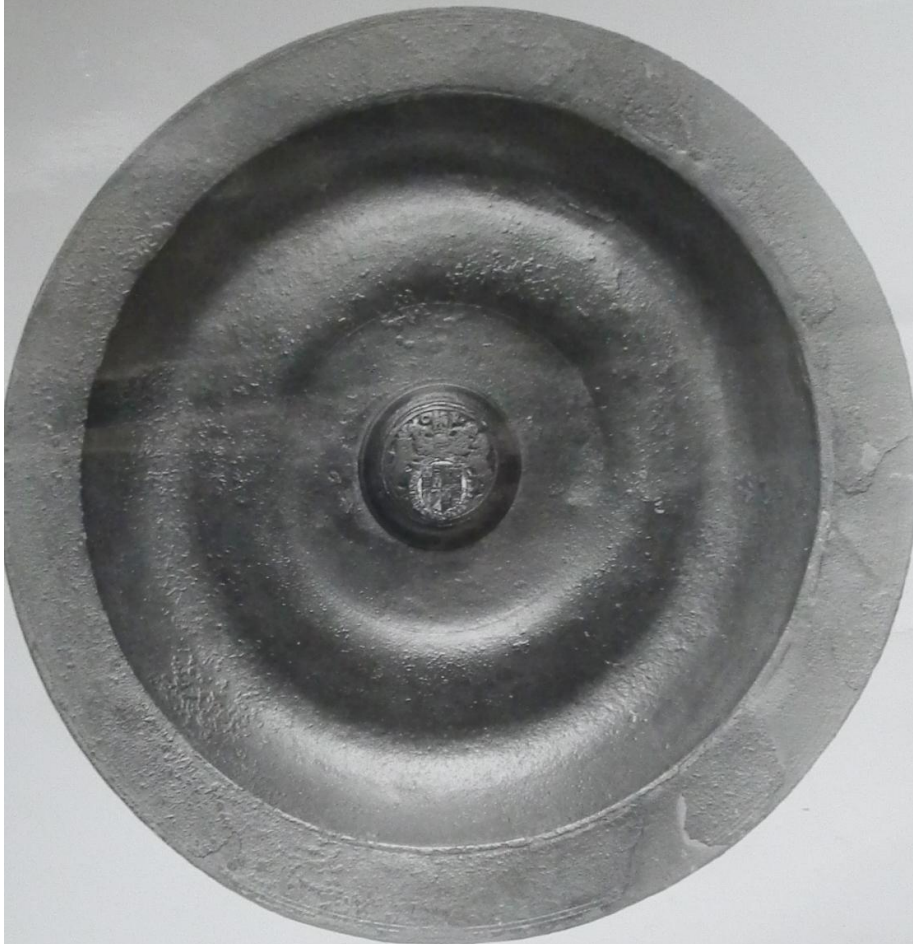
