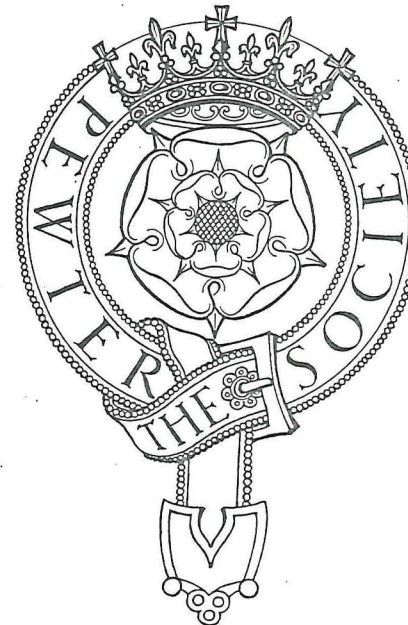

Dear Mr. Wetton,

Boyne Traders Tokens

Thank you for your letter of the 19th., with reference to the Revised Edition of this book which my late father published long years ago.

It is true I have in my possession a copy of the bulky large Paper Edition, Two Volumes, which had been sent up to me at the time of my father's last illness, and which purported to have been annotated by him. It was then put away unopened until recently, and I have since discovered that it is not annotated but merely contains various letters, lists, and cuttings, of which my father probably intended to make use some time or other. I feel, therefore, that in view of this you may prefer not to make a special expedition to this rather inaccessible house (Downlands), but rather to look the book over at Mr. Dolphin's office, to which I could send it, sometime when you are in Guildford. If otherwise, however, the last date you give, April 7th., would be the most convenient to me, since I am here in London all the week except on Saturdays.

I gathered - possibly incorrectly - that you had in mind the preparation of a revised Edition, which, indeed, may well be desirable from the point of view of scholarship, since not only was this book published so long ago, but my father, who was gifted with an amazingly quick-working brain and handicapped, perhaps, by abundant enthusiasms, did not invariably pause to embark upon the laborious but necessary process of checking and counter-checking before completing the work he had in mind at the time. It has thus often been possible for others to make use of the foundations he had laid, and to build upon them scientifically.

I must not conclude this rather lengthy letter without expressing a fear that it might not be easy, nowadays, to find a publisher for any such revision. Such a book must be long, and would appeal only to a limited circle of scholars, and Public Libraries; so that while it would be impossible to print the considerable number which present heavy production costs would require, it might, contrariwise, be equally difficult to restrict the number and to publish at a price which would not be unduly high.

Letter from Cuthbert Williamson to John Wetton, dated 21st March 1956.

INTRODUCTION

My father, John Wetton, died in Woking in August 1988, after a lifetime spent collecting 17th century traders' tokens and their literature.

Although he left few notes about his early, pre-war years as a collector, in conversations with him he recalled a momentous journey to nearby Guildford from his home in Woking to meet George C. Williamson, in 1930. Williamson, who forty years earlier had written the standard reference work on 17th century tokens, gave him a handful of Guildford tokens to start his collection, as well as useful and friendly advice.

From these modest beginnings, the collection grew. The Surrey series provided the core, followed by Kent, Southwark and London (in particular, the coffee house series). In post-war years, while prices remained relatively low, he expanded the collection to countrywide proportions; at its peak, in 1976, it contained nearly 3,500 tokens.

He claimed that it was probably one of the largest in existence outside the British Museum and Norweb collections, notable for the high proportion of "unpublished" and rare specimens, for a number of leaden and silver pieces, and for many pieces with known pedigrees. These were not always noted on his storage envelopes but they included examples from the collections of Boyne, Williamson, Willoughby, Manton, Taffs, Goostrey, Young, Kilburne, Faulkner, Carthew, and Lloyd.

In latter years, he concentrated his collecting of tokens to just Surrey (which remained intact at his death), Southwark, and London; other counties were either sold or exchanged.

His job as a town planning Inspector in the Civil Service, travelling the country, gave him the ideal opportunity to combine business with pleasure. He used his trips to visit local museums and libraries, bookshops and coin dealers, to enhance the collection, meet fellow enthusiasts, and undertake research. At home, he was a founding member of the Woking Numismatic Society in the 1960's, and its Secretary in 1978-79.

From about 1948, when he bought a collection of books from the library of G.C. Williamson from Thomas Thorp (Bookseller) in Guildford, he began acquiring a library. He was especially proud of possessing Williamsons's copy of Boyne's "Tokens Issued in the Seventeenth Century" (1858), given to him by Cuthbert Williamson (his son), in 1955.

From the 1950's, he kept extensive "revision lists" of Williamson, the aim being to produce a full scale revised edition of "Trade Tokens Issued in the Seventeenth Century" (1889-1891). He was later to admit that the task was beyond his scope,

requiring as it did extensive knowledge of, and access to, local records and collections, which he didn't have. When Michael Dickinson mentioned to him that he was compiling a revised edition of Williamson, for Seaby's, my father gladly put at his disposal these county by county revision lists. (These have subsequently been donated to Michael Dickinson for his continuing researches.)

More modestly, his first venture into publishing was the revision of the Surrey series, which appeared in 1959. He was aided in his researches by being given access to Williamson's personal papers, by courtesy of his son, Cuthbert.

The next decade saw his most productive period as a writer. Publications followed on the Isle of Wight (1962) and Hampshire (1964) series, and in 1969 Corbitt & Hunter published his "Seventeenth Century Tradesmen's Tokens" - largely a compilation of his lecture notes to numismatic societies.

In 1970, along with other contributions from E.G. Kempson and Cyril Rowe, he helped William Underwood compile his "Corrections and additional information to:- 17th Century Tokens and Issuers of Devizes"; and finally, in 1977, on the occasion of the Marx Memorial Library's exhibition on the history of Clerkenwell, he penned a short piece on the Clerkenwell series for the Library Bulletin.

When, in 1969, he compiled an annotated bibliography for inclusion in "Seventeenth Century Tradesmen's Tokens", he recognised its limitations. It wasn't intended as a comprehensive checklist; rather, as a guide to some of the more accessible works which could be found in public libraries and museums, to help new collectors entering the field.

This catalogue, by contrast, contains everything found in my father's library and amongst his papers; later acquisitions listed are my own. Where it seemed helpful or appropriate, some of the entries have been annotated; and, where known, the provenance of titles is also given. For the sake of convenience, the county series section includes both topographical as well as specialist numismatic works.

His policy of trying to acquire a copy of everything published on the subject of traders' tokens of the 17th century, will continue; and a comprehensive bibliography of the literature is in preparation.

THE Collection of Tokens has been a favourite pursuit ever since these equivalents for money have been in existence. It has been only during the later half of the present century, however, that their collection and classification has become a scientific study. The Tokens of the 17th century, as memorials of a period which was perhaps more important and eventful than any other in English history, are acknowledged to be of the highest value. They circulated in nearly every town in the kingdom, and they bear upon them records of families, companies, buildings, ancient inns, old customs, and many matters of topographical interest. Many of the Tokens were issued by members of the Long

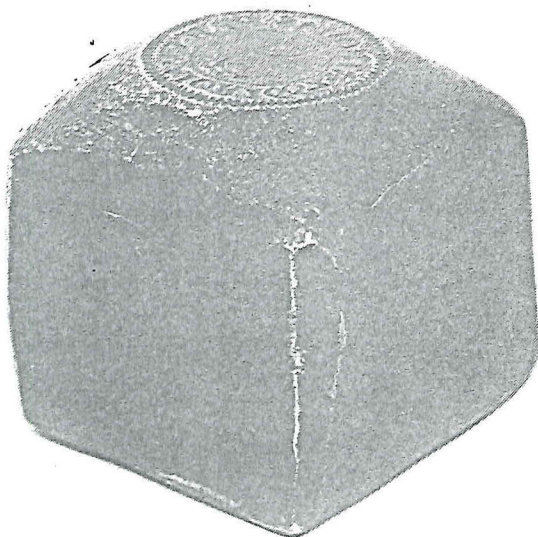
