PEWTERERS WHO RE-STRUCK THEIR TOUCH c.1670, AFTER THE GREAT FIRE OF LONDON, of 1666. (By Richard Munday.)

(L.T.P. is abbreviation for "LONDON TOUCH PLATE.")

The GREAT FIRE OF LONDON, 1666, completely destroyed Pewterers Hall. Many early records were saved and many perished with the Hall. An irretrievable loss was the destruction of the existing Touch Plates, large flat heavy-gauge sheets of pewter which must have ended up as streams of molten metal. On the now defunct Touch Plates all London pewterers were obliged to strike (stamp) their individual Touch-mark. How many did so in the 16th and 17th Centuries will never be known. If ever there was a record of their names and other particulars, it never survived the raging inferno. Pewterers' workshops, tools, moulds, metal, fittings and stock, all were destroyed by the unrelenting ferocity of the flames which raged unabated until nothing remained but scorched earth.

Without a Hall the Pewterers Company needed temporary quarters to meet. A quote from Welch, Vol. 2, page 133: "At the Miter Taverne within Algate ye 18th Septemb^r 1666 ye ffirst meeting after ye ffire. It was agreed that ye Master and Wardens now in being should provide a Couple of Sea Chests to Secure ye Books deeds Records or whatsoever writeings belong to ye Company which through ye rage of ye Late terrible ffire are now in ye Costodie of Mr Wm Rawlins as he conveyed them from ye Hall".

Many irreplaceable records were saved by the brave action of Mr. Wm. Rawlins. Some are now at the Guild Hall and others at Pewterers Hall.

The Master, Wardens and Livery now had to meet at various venues to discuss plans for a new Hall and other business. There were many problems to overcome, notably finance, and raising morale, at its lowest since the fire. Eventually plans for the new Hall were agreed and soon were well advanced. In December 1667/8 the sum of 8 shillings was paid for a new Touch-plate. It was not put into use awhile, probably for lack of a Hall.

Amazingly the re-building of the new Hall, though not quite finished, was usable in record time! The first Court since the Great Fire was held at the New Pewterers Hall on the 3rd of September, 1668/9. The actual date the pre-Great Fire pewterers were summoned to the Hall to strike their old Touch on the new Touch Plate is uncertain. Cotterell suggests c.1670. What is certain is that Touch No. 1 of the new London Touch Plate No. 1, was struck by Robert Lucas, "O.P. No. 3009".

PRE-GREAT-FIRE PEWTERERS WHO RE-STRUCK THEIR TOUCH 'c.1670 ON THE
NEW LONDON TOUCH PLATE No.1.

There are 351 Touch-marks on the new Touch Plate No.1. The first 200 or so are Touches of pewterers summoned to re-strike their old Touch, mingled with many a new Touch granted to young Freeman starting up as pewterers.

This first batch of marks seem to have been struck in a somewhat haphazard manner in contrast to the orderliness later when the Touch number gave some idea of the approximate date it was struck. On London Touch Plate No.2, with a few exceptions, pewterers who struck a Touch, number 400 or more, were not Freeman prior to c.1680.

Our Curator, Mr. Charles Hull, a direct descendant of the 17th Century family of pewterers active before and after the Great Fire, commenting on the new Touch-plate, wondered how many of the established pre-Great Fire pewterers had actually re-struck their old Touch when summoned c.1670.

This led to research and the list that follows. The earliest Touches have maker's initials only, or initials and a date or a device. Most of the others contain devices and the maker's name. All the makers on the list were Free prior to 1666, though in some cases the Touch was struck later than 1670.

Included in the list are some Company members "not following the Trade who were summoned to come on the Livery". Not working members, they were not granted a Touch, but prominent before and after 1666, they warrant inclusion.



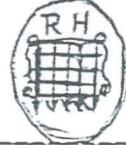

16 are complete with the maker's name and a device.

100 have the maker's initials only, and a device.

38 have the maker's initials, a device, and a date.

In addition 19 named Company members without a Touch, are listed.

No doubt a number of pre-1666 Freemen who survived the catastrophic Great Fire, were granted a Touch at a later date. None are included here.

This has been a fascinating research which it is hoped will be of interest to pewter collectors.
