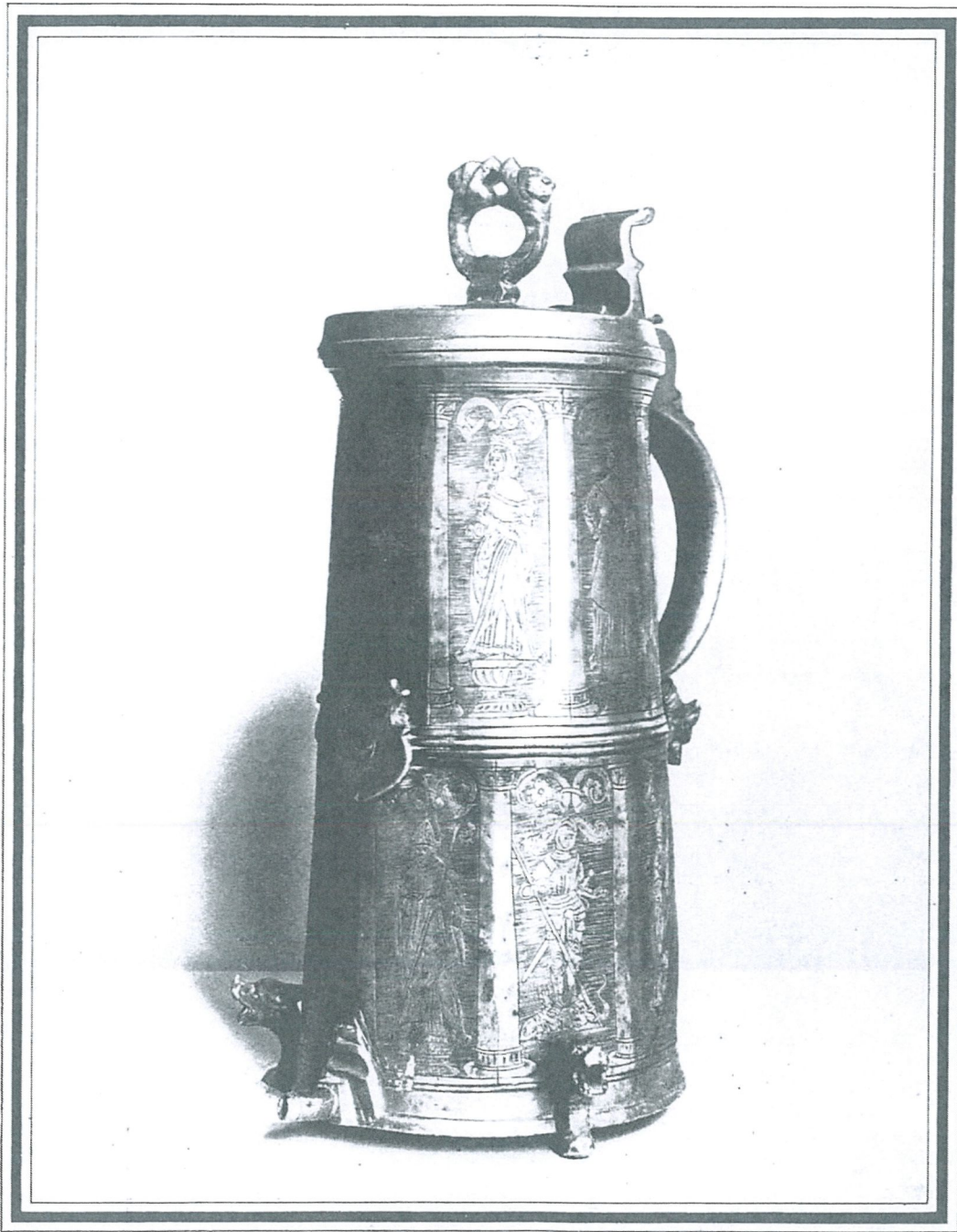

NORTH-HUNGARIAN PEWTER GUILD FLAGON (*dated 1524*)

Formerly the property of the Bootmakers of Kassa (Kaschau) in North Hungary. The engraved panels depict sundry male and female saints. The Bootmakers' symbol occurs on the applied shield. *Height:* about 24 inches. A discussion of the flagon will be found in the article on Austro-Hungarian pewter, which is published in this number.
