

NORTH-HUNGARIAN PEWTER GUILD FLAGON (dated 1524)
Formerly the property of the Bootmakers of Kassa (Kaschau) in North Hungary. The engraved panels depict sundry male and female saints. The Bootmakers' symbol occurs on the applied shield. Height: about 24 inches. A discussion of the flagon will be found in the article on Austro-Hungarian pewter, which is published in this number.
