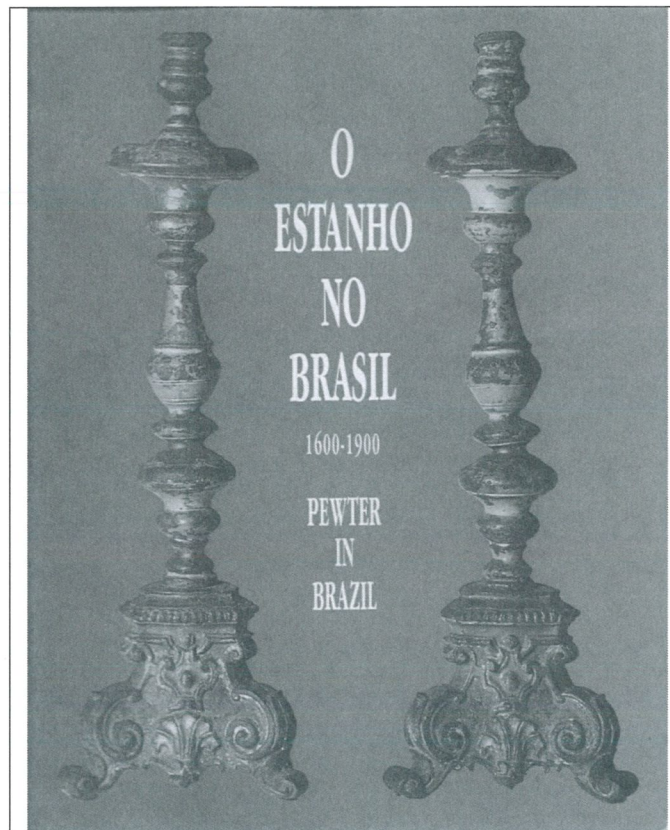

## Book Review -

# Pewter in Brazil - text by John Somers

Published about 1989 in Brazil. Text mostly in Portuguese but many descriptions of pieces also in English.

There is no apparent ISBN number and it is thought this book is out of print.



The purpose of the book is to draw attention to the extent of pewterwork in Brazil. He writes that tin was readily and easily found in Brazil on or close to the surface.

The book was produced for an exhibition of pewter in use in Brazil 1600 - 1900. It shows mostly Church pieces but also some domestic pewter.

(the book is A4 size and has 79 numbered pages. It was produced on good quality gloss paper)

Although not clear to this reviewer this book might have been produced to accompany the opening of the John Somers Museum in Sao Joao del Rey, Minas Gerais Brazil - though it seems likely to have accompanied an exhibition in 1989 that from late September to the beginning of December was displayed in Ouro Preto, Rio de Janeiro, and Sao Paulo - Brazil.
